

Declaration of Payments in the ICASA Foundation

ICASA Board

The ICASA board members do the work for the ICASA foundations without payments or fees. Whenever the ICASA Foundation has enough resources, the board will be reimbursed for their travel and hotel costs, related to ICASA Foundation activities.

ICASA Office

For maintenance of the ICASA Foundation network, organizing meetings, maintenance of the ICASA Foundation website, Public Relations, setting up new research etc., the ICASA Foundation has a formal Management agreement with the Trimbos-instituut, Netherlands institute of Mental Health and Addiction (<http://www.trimbos.org/>). Via this agreement the activities and responsibilities of the ICASA director, the ICASA management assistant and the ICASA public relations officer are registered. These professionals together form, only for a limited part of their work, the ICASA office. The ICASA office is located in the building of the Trimbos-institute, Da Costakade 45, Utrecht, the Netherlands.

The ICASA director, the ICASA management assistant and the ICASA public relations officer do not receive direct payment for their work. They are employees of the Trimbos-instituut, and perform the registered and formal activities as a consequence of the management agreement.

Post-doc Position at the University of Amsterdam

For coordination of scientific projects related to the topic of *ADHD and Substance Abuse*, the core business of the ICASA Foundation, the ICASA Foundation finances a post-doc position at the University of Amsterdam. Currently this position is for two days per week. Apart from regular salary, there are now extra payments involved.

Funding

The research projects that are undertaken via the ICASA Foundation are listed on the ICASA Foundation website. On the website page 'Funding', and via the scientific papers we produce, we report on the funding for the research projects. Thus it is always transparent where funding resources come from, and whether or not there are any conflicts of interests.
